- I. Meeting was opened late due to several FABA members stuck in traffic
- II. Thu Suong opened the meeting
- III. AVC Karen Dace shared general information about SOE consultants, their upcoming Friday Visit (Dec. 5), and a listing of faculty who had either met or were scheduled to meet with the consultants
- IV. Dean Gonzalez discussed the role of FABA and the importance of the committee's work in addressing not only issues surrounding racial climate, but also ensuring adherence to and where necessary revision of specific policies
- V. Visiting faculty members and guests (Hughes, Maxcy, Magee, Scheurich, Thorius, Scribner, Flowers, Dace) offered various perspectives on issues related to policies, procedures, and overall racial climate in the SOE
