Elementary Teacher Education Program

December 2013

Policy Statement: Students in the <u>Elementary Teacher Education</u> or <u>Elementary T2T Program</u> may complete only one dual license student teaching placement (i.e. ESL, Reading, Special Education, or Middle School Content Area) as part of their teacher education program of study. Any students who complete the coursework for a second or third dual license will have to register for an additional six-credit (6 weeks) undergraduate student teaching placement or a three-credit (16 weeks) graduate practicum for each additional license. Students who register for the graduate practicum option can complete the practicum in their own classroom if the context is appropriate for the additional license area.
